2. Main areas of responsibility :

In view of a new research programme on ICT and ICT-enabled Innovation, the JRC-IPTS is establishing a research team that would be led by one or two senior researchers specialised in ICT, Innovation policies and Economics. - a keen interest and focus on technological change (ICT)
