2nd EURO-MEDITERRANEAN SUMMER SCHOOL 2009

(EMUNI Summer 2009)

EMUNI University launches a Call for the 2nd Euro-Mediterranean Summer School aiming:

- to promote diversity and equal opportunity in the field of education,
- to build a challenging and innovative teaching and learning environment that will attract outstanding students,
- to support cooperation among universities and
- to stimulate the mobility of professors and students from all over the world, especially from Euro-Mediterranean countries.

EMUNI University will issue a Certificate of Attendance to all participants and the Transcript of Records with the obtained ECTS credits to those who will successfully complete their study obligations.

The call has two phases:

- A: application for co-organizing institution,
- B: application for students.

A: Application for co-organizing institution

Co-founding institutions of EMUNI University are invited to submit proposals for EMUNI Summer School 2009. Up to 10 courses are planned to be organized. To submit the proposal institutions need to fill in [Application Form](#).

B: Application for students and other participants

Students from all over the world are welcome to attend Summer School courses. Application form will be available from February 2, 2009.

Location:

In different countries around the Mediterranean Sea, at EMUNI co-founding institutions.

Term:

2 or 3 weeks between 1st June and 30th September 2009.

Courses characteristics:

- Institution can submit proposals for up to 2 postgraduate courses with ECTS credits.
- Recommended languages of courses are English or French.
- Courses should be delivered on the basis of blended learning, a combination of face to face (2-3 weeks) and e-learning.
- Each course should be delivered by 2 to 3 professors, at least 1 professor coming from the EU and at least 1 professor from the non EU countries (members of the Union for the Mediterranean). Professors need to be from EMUNI co-founding institutions.
- During delivery of the course institution should organise at least one social event, one trip and in each week one round-table.
- Co-organizing institution needs to ensure multicultural learning environment (participants need to be from EU as well as from non EU countries - members of the Union for the Mediterranean).
- Courses should focus on areas that significantly contribute to the understanding between peoples and cultures.

Participants registration:

- Co-organizing institution will register participants for the courses and will be responsible for administrative arrangements.

Finance:

EMUNI University can give up to 10.000 Euro per course to co-organizing institution. The funds should primarily be used to cover costs of up to 3 professors (accommodation costs, meals and transport/economy class) and the scholarship for the participants (accommodation costs, tuition fee and meals). The financial contribution of EMUNI University will not exceed 50% of total costs per course.
