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

#### LIFELONG LEARNING AT EMUNI: ADULT EDUCATION AND FREE STANDING COURSES

The implementation of courses of the accredited study programmes is a form of formal education. In case that the participants fulfil all study obligations they receive a transcript of records with obtained ECTS credits. This certificate can at a later stage be used for entering study programmes in terms of validating their previous education / learning.







#### **TEACHING METHODS**

Courses will be delivered on the basis of blended learning, a combination of online (4 June - 30 September) and face-to-face (28 June - 9 July) tuition (max. 30 students). Beside theory and presentation of main concepts, courses will also include case studies and group work. Study materials for courses will be available in the e-classroom.

#### ASSESSMENT METHODS

Discussion and active participation, examination, final assignment on selected topic (it is usually submitted within one month after the conclusion of the course).

#### OTHER ACTIVITIES

Roundtable with invited experts will be organised. Participants will visit Piran and other places of interest such as Bled, Karts region and Ljubljana.

#### CERTIFICATE AND ECTS

All participants of courses will receive a Certificate of Attendance issued by EMUNI University. Participants that will successfully complete their study obligations will receive the Transcript of Records with obtained ECTS credits.

#### **REGISTRATION AND TUITION FEE**

Registration fee: 100 EUR Tuition fee: 200 EUR (for each course) Fees cover the course, study materials and other organised activities.

#### **FINANCIAL AID**

Participants can ask for financial aid for the tuition fee and/or accommodation in the Student Residence. Grants will be awarded on the basis of a recommendation letter and the grade point average of the current or previous study and availability of financial resources. Priority will be given to participants coming from non EU countries of the Union for the Mediterranean.

#### ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS

Student Residence at EMUNI: approx. 10 EUR per person/day in a double room (the number of places is limited).

Meals at the Student Residence: approx. 12 EUR (full board) per person/day.

#### EMUNI PROFESSIONAL SCHOOL

At the request of companies or other organisations EMUNI University may implement free standing courses for specific groups. In these cases the time and place of implementation may be adjusted to the preferences of the group.
