CALL FOR "EMUNI" EXPERTS EuropeAid Co-operation with EMUNI University – ENPI 2009

The EMUNI University is looking for key-experts willing to participate in the project ENPI 2009. The aim of this call is to establish an available "EMUNI" key-experts list; from which an expert may be called to participate in the project. The list will be valid up to the end of 2011. **The call was extended** and is open up to 30 April 2010.

1 SCOPE OF THE PROJECT

General

Project description:

The project intends to sustain and support the development of academic mobility, tune the academic accreditation and validation processes of university and professional education within the Union for the Mediterranean and serve as a reference to future cooperation amongst academic and professional bodies within the region for Ministerial and Institutional cooperation in line with the external dimension of the Bologna Process and the parallel initiatives established on the international level in professional qualifications and academic mobility. It should also serve as a platform of possible cooperation with the European Research Area and the ancillary initiatives which bring together the world of work with the world of academia.

The project focuses on the mission of the EMUNI University which includes:

- Developing quality of higher education through the implementation of study and research programmes;
- Aiming to become an international university with a special focus on cultural diversity;
- Establishing an environment which will have a stimulating effect on connecting different nationalities and cultures in an academic sphere.

The aim of EMUNI university ENPI project 2009 is bringing new innovative solutions in Euro-Mediterranean region on priority fields of Union for the Mediterranean:

- De-pollution of the Mediterranean,
- Maritime and Land Highways,
- Civil protection,
- Alternative Energies,
- Higher education and Research,
- The Mediterranean Business development Initiative.

Main tasks:

Key-experts will participate in:

- Developing new postgraduate study programmes in the field of Union for Mediterranean priorities,
- Developing University Policies,
- Dissemination of project achievements (Journals, Regional days, Conferences),
- Developing academic and scientific innovation.

Key-experts will work in teams of 4-5 members with a coordinator for each team. Each key-expert will be asked to: attend 1 to 2 meetings and/or sent on a mission in the Euro-Mediterranean region, and will be asked to provide specific conclusions/expertises about the accomplished tasks.

2 REQUIRED SKILLS ANS COMPETENCES OF PARTICIPANTS (key-experts)

Experience areas:

Experts are expected to have appropriate experience, skills and knowledge including high level of professional expertise in one (or more) of the following areas:

- Developing master study programmes,
- Specific knowledge in International politics,
- Knowledge in a Regional (Mediterranean) area,
- General knowledge and experience in High education and Research area.

Profile of candidates:

a) Qualifications and skills required:

- A level of education which corresponds to completed university studies of at least four years with a diploma and, a master degree or PhD, in the field related to the areas of EMUNI project;
- A good command of English and/or French and, preferably, other foreign languages within the Union for the Mediterranean knowledge are an asset.

b) General and specific professional experience:

- at least six years of professional experience related to the area of developing master programmes in EMUNI project;
- experience in team working, preferably in international and multicultural environment;
- preferably demonstrate international experience, through study or work outside his/her country of origin

3 HOW TO APPLY

Interested candidates are invited to fill in the application form of interest of participation in EMUNI University ENPI 2009 Project available on www.emuni.si/en/form6. After completion and confirmation you will receive an e-mail with filled form. Received form has to be printed, signed and sent, including all demanded attachments:

- a curriculum vitae, preferably in an Europass form,
- certificates that prove the fulfilment of all requirements in this call (a copy of the highest education level obtained (PhD) and/ or any document proving that the candidate has participated in developing postgraduate study programmes, if any available),
- at least two letters of reference,
- a copy of valid Passport.

All the submitted document must be send by 30 April (taking into consideration a date on a letter received with a stamp of post office).

All applications dully compiled by participants, signed, accompanied with proper attachments and send before the deadline, will be evaluated by EMUNI University bodies and then submitted to the European Commission for final confirmation.
