It is organised by the **European Inter-University Centre for Human Rights and Democratisation (EIUC)** and is the primary Programme of the **European Union** to educate professionals in the field of human rights and democratisation.

This Master offers an action and policy-oriented approach to learning about international relations, law, philosophy, history and anthropology of human rights. Students have the opportunity to meet and be taught by **leading academics** representing the 41 E.MA participating universities, **experts and representatives of international organisations** (including the European Union, the United Nations, the Council of Europe and the Organisation for Security and Co-operation in Europe-OSCE) and NGOs while studying in a **multicultural environment**.
